Sujet de thèse / projet de recherche en quelques lignes :

My research studies the phenomenon of paramilitary volunteer groups that developed in Ireland in the early 20th century. Underlying the study are four organisations founded between 1909 and 1913 within the Unionist, Nationalist, and Trade Unionist movements.

In addition to analysing similarities and differences, some of the topics of study are the use of culture and propaganda, the reaction by institutions, legality, and the historical precedents of the use of political violence in the emergence of these organisations.

The aim of this research is therefore to understand the emergence of paramilitarism in modern times in liberal societies before the Great War from a European and global perspective.

During my Master's degree at the University of Padua, I decided to spend a semester abroad as an Erasmus student and by chance I decided on Dublin. During this time I decided to write my research thesis on Irish history having spoken to some Italian and Irish researchers.
